



AURA LANDSCAPING OWNER ACKNOWLEDGED FOR USE OF NATURAL STONE IN GARDEN

Participating in Canada Blooms blossomed into a great opportunity for Scott Duff.

The St. Catharines entrepreneur, who operates Aura Landscaping, recently earned accolades on a national stage. For two weeks last month the landscaper participated in Canada Blooms at the Direct Energy Centre, Exhibition Place, in Toronto.

The event, Canada's largest flower and garden festival, featured 15 feature gardens, and Duff had the privilege of designing one of them. He not only had the opportunity to showcase his work in front natural stone for his garden.

"It was a great honour to be recognized for my work," he said. "It was really a fantastic experience."

His entry, Urban Passions, was a 600-squarefoot creation that incorporated more than 68,000 lbs. of stone into its design. Duff didn't just exhibit his work at Canada Blooms. He practically lived there. He spent 150 hours doing the pre-build and setup, and then spent more than 14 hours a day at the show, man-

ning his booth.

In addition to the award, Duff also had the HGTV and Canada AM, and he even met gardening expert Mark Cullen.

More importantly, he said, he was also able to meet new people who have since come on board as customers.

"It's pretty humbling to have people come up to me and say, 'We want to hire you," he said, noting he welcomed people from Fort Erie, Niagaraon-the-Lake, St. Catharines and beyond at the

show. "It was really a great chance to open some new doors for me."

Duff was also thrilled to give back during the event. One of the sculptures that was a centrepiece in his garden was crafted and then auctioned off for charity, in support of cancer research, raising more than \$1,000.

This week Duff will be showcasing his work back in Niagara. He will be setting up shop at the Niagara Home and Garden Show, set to take place April 13-14 at the Grimsby Peach King Centre.
